











Ela Menescal is a Brazilian artist born on February 5, 1987, in Rio de Janeiro. She grew up in a musical and artistic environment; her own school notebooks were expressive and fun. The paths took her to Law, at the Candido Mendes University, where she perfected the art of arguing and became illustrated with classical culture.

She worked in the field of Intellectual Property and Fashion Law bridging a gap between Law and Fashion. In 2017, she became a fashion stylist, graduating with international certification from IRCNY (Image Resource Center of New York).

Her collage works began at first, as a way of disseminating fashion and style.

From these compositions, Ela Menescal's desire to migrate to the field of art and, with the mastery of technique and the approach of contemporary issues. Her production expands at an intense, original and invariably creative pace.

The artist maintains lightness and poetry in her visual compositions, without leaving aside irony and criticism of current times. Her work has several layers in which characters present in a collective memory, song lyrics, phrases, colors and, in her words, "a lot of light!".

He held individual and group exhibitions in Rio de Janeiro. She participated in the SP-Arte fair in 2022 and in ArtRio in 2020. Her artwork was selected by the Royal Academy of Arts for the Summer Exhibition 2022.
